Ottawa, ON- The Canadian Alliance of Student Associations is pleased to present recommendations to the Standing Committee on Finance today as part of the 2012 pre-budget consultations.

CASA will convey the need to adapt the Canada Student Loans Program (CSLP) to reflect the real needs of students today, the importance of substantial changes to the Post-Secondary Student Support Program (PSSSP) and the need for amendments in forthcoming copyright legislation.

“This is a great opportunity to advance realistic proposals to the Federal Government that will improve the lives of Canadian students and result in a high return on investment for government.” said Zach Dayler, National Director of CASA.

CASA continues to call for a national dialogue between the federal government and provincial and territorial governments on post-secondary education and encourages policymakers at all levels to commit to solving our nation’s post-secondary education issues.
